

THE ROBIN ORR OUTSTANDING PRACTITIONER AWARD

This award recognizes significant contributions of leadership/service by a distinguished practitioner in their related field.

Eligibility: Nominees must meet the following criteria.

1. Applicants must be ALE members in good standing
2. Applicants must have achieved 10 years of professional service in their respective
3. field.
4. Applicants may not have already received this award.
5. Applicants must be nominated by another member of ALE (individually or as part of
6. a group of nominators).
7. Applicants must have made significant contributions of leadership and
8. service in their profession.

Nomination: Submit a description, not to exceed 3 double-spaced pages of 12 point font, outlining the following information:

1. Nominee with contact information (name, address, email address, phone)
2. Primary professional role/field of nominee
3. Nature of contribution
4. Length of leadership and service
5. Significance and impact of leadership and service
6. Other significant and/or pertinent information
7. Applicants will be selected by a committee of ALE members who report to the
1. Director of Awards & Recognition.

Selection: One recipient will be selected by the ALE Awards and Recognition Committee. Applications will be judged on the following criteria:

2. Nature of Leadership and Service 30 points
3. Significance of Leadership and Service 30 points
4. Length of Leadership and Service 30 points
5. Other significant factors 10 points
6. Total 100 points

Presentation: Award will consist of a recognition item (determined by the committee) and recognition at the 2012 Conference.
