

## ALE DISTINGUISHED TEACHING AWARD INFORMATION

This award recognizes an ALE member for their contribution to advancing leadership education through outstanding teaching and learning.

**Eligibility:** Nominees must meet the following eligibility criteria.

1. Applicants must be ALE members in good standing at time of award application submission.
1. Applicants may not have already received the award.
2. Applicants must submit two letters of recommendation (colleague or supervisor; current or former student)
3. Applicants must demonstrate innovative and quality teaching and learning practice.
4. Applicants should be employed in a professional role that includes at least 50% teaching.

**Application Form:** This application should be submitted in the form of a self-nomination letter (2 pages maximum), Curriculum Vitae, and letters of reference (see below).

Self-nomination letter should address the following criteria:

1. An overview of applicant's teaching and learning context, program, or community
2. Overview of teaching philosophy
3. Example of effective classroom teaching and learning practice (e.g., innovative instruction or assessment)
4. Example of non-classroom teaching practice (e.g., advising student organizations)
5. Pursuit of professional development in the area of leadership teaching and learning

Please include two letters of support from (1) a colleague or supervisor and (2) a current or former student.

Please include a 2 page Curriculum Vitae highlighting courses taught, teaching accomplishments, and/or special certifications as well as relevant scholarship.

**Selection:** One recipient will be selected by the ALE Awards and Recognition Committee.

**Presentation:** Award will consist of a recognition item (determined by the committee) and recognition at the annual Conference.

**All applications due by 11:59 pm, EST, Friday, April 21, 2017.**
