

ALE RISING STAR: EARLY CAREER LEADERSHIP & SERVICE AWARD INFORMATION

This award recognizes an early career ALE member whose leadership and service upholds and embodies our association's mission: *to strengthen and sustain the expertise of professional leadership educators.*

Eligibility: Nominees must meet the following eligibility criteria.

1. Applicants must be ALE members in good standing at time of award application submission.
2. Applicants may not have already received the award.
3. Applicants must be nominated by another member of ALE
4. Applicants must have made a significant contribution of leadership, service, and/or scholarship to the Association and/or the field of leadership education as an ALE member for 5 years or less (not including student membership).

Application Form:

This application should be submitted in the form of a nomination letter (2 pages maximum). The letter should address the following criteria:

1. Nature of relationship to the nominee
2. A description of the nominee's professional role
3. Description of leadership and service and/or scholarly contributions to the association and/or broader field of leadership education
4. Explanation of how this member upholds and embodies ALE mission
5. Other significant and/or pertinent information

Please be sure to include the contact information of both the *Nominator(s)* and Nominee (name, address, email address, phone).

Selection: One recipient will be selected by the ALE Awards and Recognition Committee.

Presentation: Award will consist of a plaque and recognition at the annual Conference.

All applications due by 11:59 pm, EST, Friday, April 21, 2017.
