ALE will be presenting up to four awards to outstanding graduate and undergraduate students **who attend and present** at the annual ALE conference. NOTE: *This is a self-nomination award.*

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be students in good academic standing at the time of the nomination. Please verify this before you submit the application.
- Recipients of this award are required to present or co-present at the ALE conference the year the award is received. It is expected that individuals who wish to receive this award, submit an application by the deadline, regardless of notification regarding their conference proposal. The Awards & Recognition committee will collaborate with the Conference Planning committee to determine eligibility.
- Applicants may not have already received the award for each category: (undergraduate and graduate levels).

Information Needed in Application Packet:

1. Name, Address, Phone Number, Email
2. College/University
3. Major
4. Year in School (Graduate or Undergraduate)
5. Expected Graduation Date
6. Current GPA
7. Career Goal(s) (In 50 words or less).
8. Titles and Categories of Proposals Submitted to the ALE conference
9. Please respond to the following questions (maximum of 50 words per question):
 - a. What are your particular interests/concerns/goals in studying leadership?
 - b. How will you benefit from attending the ALE conference?
 - c. How will you share what you learned at ALE with others?
 - d. What role do you see leadership education playing in our world's future?
10. **Reference:** Please ask a faculty member or other qualified person to write a letter of support for your application (including verification of good academic standing) and submit with your nomination. This should be included in your single file PDF upload.

Presentation: Award will consist of a recognition item (to be determined by the Awards Committee), complimentary conference registration, and recognition at the annual conference.

All applications due by 11:59 pm (PDT), Monday, April 2, 2020.
